

- 61 Dispatched Incidents (137 total Incidents for 2024)



Incidents to Mention:

- Provided mutual aid support for 3 structure fires and 1 scrap yard fire in UCFD1.
- Cardiac Arrest at Two Rivers.

- Tires will be needed for E-11 (4) rear sometime mid-year.
- SCBA cylinders were hydrostatically tested. This is required every 5 years.
